REGISTRATION

If you are a Lancaster County resident, age 55 or older, you are invited to participate in the Games. Your registration fee of \$15, **due by Friday, April 19**, enables you to compete in an unlimited number of events. A registration form can be found on **page 17**.

T-SHIRTS

AGE DIVISIONS

Age divisions are 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95 and over. The age division of partners is based on age of younger participant. Players may only play in one age category.

1st, 2nd & 3rd place ribbons are awarded in each age group.

PARTICIPATION & CANCELLATION

The event coordinators reserve the right to cancel events due to inclement weather or to consolidate age divisions for competition based on insufficient entries. In event of inclement weather check Lancaster Senior Games Facebook page for cancellation notice of outdoor events. Participants must check in at events at least 15 minutes prior to start time with the exception of Drop-In events.



SENIOR GAMES FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. FOR PARTNER EVENTS: Where on the registration form do I list my partner's name? You don't need to list the partner's name unless it's for 18-hole golf or Pitch and Putt. What if I don't have a partner? We will pair anyone without a partner. My partner is younger or older than I am. In which age group do we register? For partnered events, you sign up for the younger partner's age group.
- FOR BRACKET EVENTS: Registration closes at the time the event is listed in the brochure. You should be at the event 15 minutes prior, so you don't miss registration. Once registration is closed, volunteers are NOT able to add you to the brackets.
- 3. I need to register later than April 19th. Will you accept my registration? NO. We have a lot of computer work to get ready for the games, so we need a strict cut off date/time. Registrations must be at the Office of Aging, The Groff's Family Funeral and Cremation Services Inc., or submitted online by 4:30pm on April 19th. Anything received after that time will be rejected and returned to the sender.
- 4. I registered for the games but now I can't attend. Can I get my money back? Unfortunately, we are not set up to give refunds. The only time credit is given is for Golf events that are cancelled because of rain. Vouchers are given to participants who paid the fees. Vouchers can be collected at the Golf course within 1 week after the event date.
- 5. Where can I pick up my T-shirt? Shirts are available 9am- 4:30pm at The Groff's Family Funeral and Cremation Services Inc. until April 19th. Participants must provide proof of registration online, or by submitting their registration and payment at Groff's front desk. After that time, shirts can be picked up at Spooky Nook Sports May 6, 7 or 8th.
- 6. Where can I pick up my medal? Medals are available at the end of the day for the events. Medals will be located at the information desk at Spooky Nook on May 7th and 8th. On May 9th the medals are available at Leisure Lanes, and on May 10th at the Celebration Event at Longs Park. The Groff's Family Funeral and Cremation Services Inc. will have the medals Monday, May 13 Friday, May 17th from 9am-4:30pm. After that time, participants should call Office of Aging to arrange pick up of their medals at the office. After May 31st, the medals are no longer available.
- 7. Where can I find event results? We keep names/times of the medal winners. We don't keep the score sheets for every participant. The result sheets are available where the medals are located. They will also be posted on www.LancSeniorGames.org the week after the Senior Games.
- 8. **How much is lunch?** The cost of lunch is subsidized by The Office of Aging. Participants who want lunch will pay \$5 toward the cost each day. Lunches must be ordered and prepaid with registration.
- 9. Its raining, how do I know that events are cancelled? We don't have immediate access to our website so we can only post the cancellation on our Facebook page. The running event will be cancelled if it is raining. We need to be considerate of our volunteers as well as participants when weather is bad. Pickleball rain date is Friday, May 10th.
- 10. Why isn't my event offered anymore? The Senior Games committee looks at attendance and makes decisions based on the number of people participating in events and the costs associated with the event.








